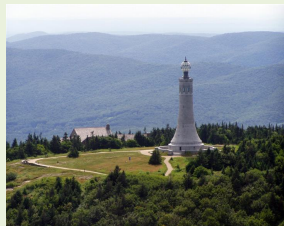

## 2018 Guided Hikes of Williamstown Trails, and A Series of Greylock to Greylock “Ring” Hikes

Bring water, sunscreen, and snack. Wear good shoes/boots.  
No need to sign up. Severe weather cancels. Info at [www.wrlf.org](http://www.wrlf.org)



**Saturday June 16: “Williamstown Ring Hike” Series Hike #1- Greylock Summit to Roaring Brook Rd.** Each segment of this guided hike series will feature a hike around Williamstown clockwise from Mt. Greylock. The first hike starts at the summit, then to Stony Ledge, and the Roaring Brook trailhead. Strenuous 4.4 miles, but downhill! Meet at Roaring Brook trailhead on Roaring Brook Road at 9:00 a.m.

**Saturday June 30: Ring Hike #2 - Phelps Trail to Petersburg Pass over Berlin Mountain.** A moderately strenuous hike along the Taconic Crest Trail with a panoramic view from atop Berlin Mountain. 4.2 miles. Meet at Petersburg Pass at 9AM and carpool to Phelps trailhead.



**Saturday July 7: Ring Hike #3 - Petersburg Pass to Hopkins Memorial Forest, via Taconic Crest Trail and Birch Brook Trail.** Hikers meet at the Hopkins Forest parking lot off Northwest Hill Rd. at 9 am and carpool to Petersburg Pass. 2.4 miles, moderate.

**Saturday July 28: Ring Hike #4 - Over East Mountain, via Chestnut Trail, Class of '98 Trail, and Appalachian Trail.** Hikers meet at 9 am at Greylock School on Phelps Ave., in North Adams, and carpool to the trailhead on Chestnut St. One of the most popular hiking areas in Williamstown, strenuous 3.6 miles.

**Saturday August 11: Ring Hike #5 – Climbing Greylock via the Appalachian Trail.** Appalachian Trail from Pattison Rd. up to Notch Rd. Meet at 9 am at Wilbur Clearing parking lot on Notch Rd. (Will carpool back to Pattison Rd.) 2.2 miles. Strenuous.

**Saturday August 25: Ring Hike #6 - Climbing Greylock via the Appalachian Trail.** Appalachian Trail from Notch Rd. up to summit of Mt. Greylock. Meet at 9 am at Mt. Greylock summit parking lot and carpool down to trailhead. 3.2 miles. Moderate.



**Saturday September 15: Berlin Ridge.** Berlin Pass Rd. to Berkshire Natural Resources Council ridge trail to Taconic Crest, and back down Berlin Pass Rd. Moderately strenuous. 2.2 miles. Meet at 9 am at the end of Berlin Rd.

**Saturday October 13: Stone Hill Trails.** A loop hike with geological interpretation. Easy. Meet at 9 am at the Lunder Center (Stone Hill Center) at the Clark Art Institute.
