Saturday, May 18 (easy, family friendly)

Hemlock Brook and Harmon Pond (2 hours)

Meet 9:00 am at Margaret Lindley Park, corner of Rts. 2 & 7, Williamstown.

Saturday, June 15* (strenuous)

Up to Stony Ledge via Haley Farm Trail, down via Hopper Trail (3+ hours)

Meet at 9:00 am at parking lot end of Hopper Rd., Williamstown.

Saturday, July 6* (strenuous)

Phelps and Taconic Crest Trails to Petersburg Pass (3+ hours)

Meet at 9:00 at Petersburg Pass, carpool from there to Phelps Trailhead, Oblong Rd., Williamstown.

Sunday, July 21* (moderate)

Petersburg Pass to Hopkins Forest via Taconic Crest and Birch Brook Trails

(3+ hours)

Meet at 9:00, at Hopkins Memorial Forest parking lot, Northwest Hill Rd., Williamstown. Carpool to Petersburg Pass.

Sunday, August 4* (strenuous)

Climb Pine Cobble, Class of '98, Appalachian Trails over East Mt. (3+ hours)

Meet at 9:00 at Greylock School parking lot, Phelps Ave., North Adams. Carpool to Chestnut St.

Saturday, August 17* (moderate)

Mt. Greylock Summit, down via Appalachian Trail past Prospect Mt. (3+ hours)

Meet at 9:00 at Appalachian Trail parking lot, Pattison Rd., North Adams. Carpool to summit.

Saturday, August 31* (moderate and strenuous)

Stony Ledge Trail to Stony Ledge, down via Roaring Brook Trail (3+ hours)

Meet at 9:00 Roaring Brook trailhead, Roaring Brook Rd., Williamstown.

Saturday, September 14 (strenuous)

Taconic Crest Trail via Berlin Ridge Trail, down Berlin Pass Trail (3+ hours)

Meet at 9:00 at parking lot at end of Berlin Rd., Williamstown.

Saturday, October 12 (easy)

Stone Hill Trails with expert commentary on geology (2 hours)

Meet at 9:00 at parking lot of Clark Institute's Lunder Center (Stone Hill) South St., Williamstown.

Saturday, November 9 (moderate)

Tenney Woods, over Tenney Hill and through Treadwell Hollow (3+ hours)

Meet at 9:00 at parking lot on Rt. 2, halfway up Taconic Trail on left, Williamstown.
